Procedure of Internal Assessment Marks for CAL-C Courses

- 1. The procedure for collating the Internal Assessment (IA) marks awarded to the students is outlined in the succeeding paragraphs.
- 2. The student must submit assignments in each subject per semester to the CAL-C Centre. Class Performance & assignment will be considered for grading for IA by CAL-C Centre. The IA will be of 20% marks of the main theory paper, 15% for assignment + 05% marks for class performance.
- 3. Centre Heads of CAL-C Centres will award marks to the students based on the assignments submitted by them during the respective semester + class performance. The marks would then be tabulated and forwarded in the form of soft copy in a CD, along with the hard copy duly signed, stamped and dated so as to reach our office at the time of submission of semester term examinations record to the CAL-C Head Office, Chandigarh.
- 4. Sending both the soft copy and the hard copy of the assessment as per format below is mandatory. Failure to do so will result in withholding of the results.
- 5. Mandatory to pass by scoring 40% or above in theory paper i.e. 80 out of 32 is required to pass in each respective subjects of the course.
- 6. IA marks statement will only be accepted once and subsequent dispatches or amendments will not be accepted.
- 7. In the event of any difference in IA marks between the hard and soft copy, only the marks in the soft copy will be considered for declaring the results.
- 8. All the records related to IA i.e. assignment, class tests etc must be maintained at the CAL-C Centre atleast for a period of 1 year after the declaration of the results and the same must be made available to the CAL-C Head Office or its representative as and when demanded.
